The tenders accompanied with earnest money @ 2 % of quoted amount in the shape of CDR/FDR from any Nationalized / Scheduled Bank pledged to Chief Pay and Accounts Officer, JKSPDC Kangan. The detailed tender document can be had from the office of the undersigned w.e.f. 30-12-2011 to 05-01-2012 during office hours.

The tenders in the sealed cover should reach to the office of the Executive Engineer Generation Division Ganderbal on or before 10-01-2012 upto 2.00 p.m by registered post or by hand.

The rates to be quoted should be inclusive of all taxes and duties presently in vogue. There should be no over writing or mutilations in the rates quoted and should be written both in words as well as in figures duly tixo taped.

All other terms and conditions as indicated in standardized tender document of PDC together with those as contemplated in PWD form No: 25 (double) shall remain same and unchanged.



#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The tender should be legibly written. There should be no overwriting / mutilations of rates. The rates thus quoted should be pasted with tixo tape.
2. The tenders will be opened on the same day in presence of tenderers who may wish to be present on or any other subsequent date convenient to the tender opening authority.
3. The tender opening authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotations without assigning any reasons thereof.
4. The job shall have to be completed within the stipulated period of 30 days as the time of completion is the essence of the contract.
5. In case of any delay beyond the completion period, a penalty upto the extent of 10% of the whole contract value shall be imposed upon the contractor and recovered from his dues or shall be got recovered through revenue department as the case may be.
6. No escalation/increase in allotted rates shall be allowed on any account.
7. In case of any dispute arising during the course of execution of this work, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority whose orders./ decision shall be final and binding upon the parties. Further the courts at Srinagar only shall have the jurisdiction to decide any dispute under the State Arbitration Act "Provided the Arbitral Tribunal shall have any right / jurisdiction to award

8. The funds for the job/work stands demanded and accordingly the release of payment shall depend upon availability/allotment of funds. The contractor shall not force the department for release of payment in absence of allotment/availability of funds.
9. 100% payment shall be released against successful completion of the job subject to the preferment of a certificate from the Engineer in -charge of the site to the effect that the agency has satisfactorily completed the said work and there is nothing outstanding against the agency.
10. The job shall have to be carried out in presence of department representative as per specification given in rate list / estimate.
11. As soon as the letter of intent/acceptance of rats is communicated to the successful tenderer, all the terms and conditions as stipulated above together with those as contemplated in standardized tender document of the PDC and form No. 25(double) shall get enforced even in absence of issuance of formal allotment order.
12. The quantum of work advertised being tentative shall be subject to increase or decrease upto 25 % of the total value of the tender depending upon the actual requirement at site.
13. No extension in time shall be granted. The contractor shall devise his tie schedule as such that timely completion of the work is ensured.
14. Income tax, or any other tax presently in vogue or any in case thereof during currency of the contract shall be deducted at source from the dues of the agency.
15. In case of any clerical/typographical error, the original tender document shall be referred to.
16. All the terms and conditions shall remain same as laid down in relevant PWD rules in additions to those as indicated in the NIT.
