For and on behalf of Managing Director, J&K State Power Development Corporation, sealed short term tenders accompanied with earnest money @ 2 % of the quoted amount in the shape of CDR / FDR from any Nationalized / Scheduled Bank pledged to the Chief Pay & Accounts Officer PDC Kangan, affixed with revenue stamps worth Rs. 2.00 valid for 180 days are invited by the undersigned from registered Contractors / Suppliers / Dealers whose registration certificates are valid for the current financial year and have cleared all the taxes payable towards Government, for supply of below mentioned items. The tenders in sealed cover should reach to the office of the Executive Engineer on or before 10.09.2011 upto 2 P.M. by registered post or by hand.

The rates to be quoted should be inclusive of all taxes and duties presently in vogue. There should be no overwriting or mutilations in the rates quoted and should be written both in words as well as in figures duly tixo taped.

All the terms and conditions in addition to the following, as contemplated in detailed NIT/PWD form No: 25 (double) together with those as contemplated in standardized tender document of the PDC shall remain same and unchanged.

Terms and conditions


1. The tender should be legibly written. There should be no overwriting/ mutilations of rates. The rates thus quoted should be pasted with tixo tape.

2. The tenders shall be opened on the same day in presence of the tenderers who may wish to remain present, or any other subsequent date convenient to the tender opening authority.
3. The tender opening authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
4. The supply shall have to be made within the stipulated period of one week as the time of completion is essence of the contract.
5. In case of any delay beyond the supply flow period, a penalty upto the extent of 10% of the whole contract value shall be imposed upon the contractor and recovered from his dues or shall be got recovered through revenue department as the case may be.
6. In case the material placed on order or part thereof is not found upto the mark / as per specifications / satisfaction of the Engineer in charge of the site, department shall be at liberty to reject the supplies and get the supplies arranged through any other alternative agency purely at the risk and cost of the defaulting agency.
7. No escalation / increase in allotted rates shall be allowed on any account.
8. The quantum of work advertised being tentative, shall be subject to increase or decrease upto 25% depending upon the actual requirement at site.
9. No compensation shall be paid in the event of any damage to the supplies as a result of any natural calamity such as floods, cloud burst, landslides etc.
10. The successful contractor shall have to provide his own watch and ward of his materials. In case of any theft or loss the department shall not be responsible.
11. In case of any dispute arising during the course of execution of this work, the matter shall be referred to the next higher authority whose orders / decision shall be final and binding upon the parties. Further the Courts at Srinagar only shall have the jurisdiction to decide any dispute under the State Arbitration Act.
12. The funds for the job / work stands demanded and accordingly the release of payment shall depend upon availability / allotment of funds. The contractor shall not force the department for release of payment in absence of allotment / availability of funds.
13. 100% payment shall be released against successful flow of the materials subject to preferment of a certificate from the Engineer in-charge of the site to the effect that the agency has satisfactorily completed the said work and there is nothing outstanding against the agency is received.
14. As soon as letter of intent / acceptance of rates is communicated to the successful tenderer, all the terms and conditions as stipulated abode together with those as contemplated in standardized render document of PDC and PWD form No: 25 (double) shall get enforced even in absence of issuance of formal allotment order.
15. The contractor shall have to execute an agreement with the department within 7 days from the date of issue of allotment order on PWD form No: 25(double). Till such time all the terms and conditions as contemplated in the said form together with those as stipulated in standardized tender document of PDC shall remain same and apply to the said contract.
16. No extension in time limit shall be granted. The contractor shall devise his time schedule as such that timely completion of the work is ensured.



17. Income tax, or any other tax presently in vogue or any incase thereof during currency of the contract shall be deducted at source from the dues of the agency.
18. In case of any clerical / typographical error the original tender document shall be referred to.
19. All other terms and conditions shall remain same as laid down in PWD form No: 25(double) in addition to those as indicated in the NIT.
