INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE INTENDING TENDERERS


1. The Tenders should reach in the office of the Chief Engineer (Civil) BHEP Chanderkote on or before **27.12.2011 up to 2.00 PM** through Registered/ speed post only and shall be opened on the same day or any other subsequent date convenient to opening authority in presence of such tenderer who may choose to be present at the time of opening of tenders.
2. The tender documents containing terms and conditions and schedule of quantities can be purchased from the office of Executive Engineer Civil Maintenance Division BHEP-I, Chanderkote from 17-12-2011 to 21-12-2011 on application and on production of original registration card duly renewed for the current financial year.
3. The tenderer shall have to pay Rs 500/- (Rupees Five hundred) only non-refundable in cash as cost of tender documents.
4. The tenders received after expiry of time and date shall not be entertained.
5. In case the fixed date for receipt of tenders is declared a holiday, the date of receipt of tenders shall be reckoned as the next working day.
6. Conditional tenders will be rejected.
7. The Chief Engineer (Civil) Chanderkote reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
8. The contractor should produce attested photo copy of the PAN, TIN number and Sale Tax clearance from sale tax department (latest) while purchasing of tender documents.
9. The tender should be accompanied with E/money in the form of a call deposit receipt CDR for an amount equivalent to 2% of the total advertised cost of the work (refer NIT for amount) on any schedule bank pledged to Chief Engineer (Civil) BHEP Chanderkote.
10. The earnest money will be released to the un-successful tenderers after allotment of the work.
11. In case of successful tenderer, CDR will be released*after successful completion of the work and completion of defect liability period.
12. The tender received with out CDR shall not be entertained.
13. Other conditions and rate list shall be available from this office on any working day.
14. The tender documents shall only be issued to the original contractor on proper application or to the representative of the contractor on proper authority letter under signature/seal of the contractor.
15. The date of start of work shall be reckoned after 7 days from the date of issue of allotment order.

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16. The work shall have to be completed within the stipulated period other wise the penalty up to 10% of the value of work shall be imposed on the Contractor. In case the work is left incomplete by the Contractor, the work shall be got completed by putting to fresh tender at the risk and cost of the Contractor in addition to imposition of above mentioned penalty.
17. The contractor is advised to visit the site and quote in accordance to the site/working conditions.
18. The Contractor should produce documentary evidence for arranging safe scaffolding.
19. All safety measures for the workers shall have to be ensured during the execution of the said works.
20. All sorts of hygiene shall have to be maintained in all respects during/after completion of the day's work by the workers
21. Funds are available.
