

CORRIGENDUM

Ref: All corrigenda in respect of above notifications.

In view of various representations from candidates and in order to promote more competition, the following is notified for information of all concerned:

1. Candidates with degree/ diploma in "Electrical and Electronics Engineering" from a University established by law in India/ AICTE approved Institute are eligible for the post of JE (Electrical).
2. Candidates with degree in "Electrical and Electronics Engineering" from a University established by law in India/ AICTE approved Institute are eligible for the post of JE (Automation).
3. Candidates with degree in "Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering" or "Applied Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering" from a University established by law in India/ AICTE approved Institute are eligible for the post of JE (Instrumentation).
4. S.No. 7 of the notification no: JKSPDC/ADM/NG-311/4324-33, dated 05.08.2017 may be read as under (as per Rule 14, Clause 1(b) of J&K Civil Services Decentralisation & Recruitment Rules 2010):
"Candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of marks obtained in the screening test and called for interview in the ratio of 1:5 (i.e. No. of posts: No. of candidates)"
5. S.No. 8 of the notification no: JKSPDC/ADM/EN-131/4310-16, dated 05.08.2017 may be read as under (as per Rule 14, Clause 1(b) of J&K Civil Services Decentralisation & Recruitment Rules 2010):
"Candidates will be shortlisted on the basis of marks obtained in the screening test and called for interview in the ratio of 1:5 (i.e. No. of posts: No. of candidates)"
6. The revised selection criteria for Junior Engineer posts shall be as under [in view of Hon'ble High Court Judgement in LPA(SWP) No. 126 of 2015, MP No. 01/2015 tiled Sartaj Ahmad Dar & ors v/s J&K SSRB & ors. [Ref: 2015(4) JKJ 277 (HC)]:

A. For JE (Electrical) / JE (Civil) / JE (Mechanical):

Qualification	Weightage
Marks for Screening Test	75 (Seventy Five) points on pro-rata basis
Diploma/ Degree	10 (Ten) points on pro-rata basis
Additional points for M.Tech. in relevant field from a University established by law in India/ AICTE recognised institute	5 (Five) points
Viva voce	10 (Ten) points

B. For JE (Automation):

Qualification	Weightage
Marks for Screening Test	75 (Seventy Five) points on pro-rata basis
Degree	10 (Ten) points on pro-rata basis
Additional points for M.Tech. in relevant field from a University established by law in India/ AICTE recognised institute, with 'Automation/ Industrial Automation' as one of the subjects.	5 (Five) points
Viva voce	10 (Ten) points

C. For JE (Instrumentation):

Qualification	Weightage
Marks for Screening Test	75 (Seventy Five) points on pro-rata basis
Degree	10 (Ten) points on pro-rata basis
Additional points for M.Tech. in Instrumentation from a University established by law in India/ AICTE recognised institute	5 (Five) points
Viva voce	10 (Ten) points

7. Horizontal reservation to the extent of 3% shall be applicable in respect of physically challenged candidates.
