INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED BY CANDIDATES APPEARING IN SCREENING TEST FOR VARIOUS POSTS OF JKSPDC.

DOs	DONTs
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Candidates shall have to bring hall ticket for verification along with at least one original (no photocopy or scanned copy) valid photo identification card (for example: Passport, PAN Card, Aadhaar-UID, Government Employer ID or Driving License) to secure admission to the examination hall. Card should clearly mentions the full name, parentage and date of birth.2. Candidates should be seated in the examination hall 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination.3. The test centre gate will be closed at 9:45 AM (for exams commencing at 10:00 AM), at 1:45 PM (for exams commencing at 02:00 PM), and at 3:15 PM (for exams commencing at 03:30 PM).4. Always keep the Examination Admit Card with you and show it to the supervisory staff on duty as and when required/demanded.5. Candidates should carefully read the instructions given on the admit card, the cover of the answer book as well as on the question paper.6. Candidates should record the roll number as well as the paper code correctly. The answer book of the candidates with wrong roll number/question number/paper code will not be evaluated & candidates shall themselves be	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The candidates are advised not to carry valuable devices or personal belongings to the test centers. There may not be a guaranteed security facility for safe-keeping of outside the examination hall. JKSPDC shall not be responsible for loss of any belongings.2. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the examination hall once the exam has commenced.3. Candidates shall not apply Mehendi, ink, etc on their hands.4. Do not write anything related or un-related to Examination on your Admit Card.5. The candidates should not argue with the invigilators/supervisors regarding the question paper in the exam hall. Protesting or trying to boycott the exam or disturbing other candidates shall be treated as unfair means and such candidates are liable to be declared as failed in the exam and also liable to be debarred from future examinations.6. Candidates shall not be allowed to carry any electronic gadgets, mobile phones, tablets, pen drives, Bluetooth devices, watch, calculator, log tables, wallet, purse, notes, chart, loose sheets and recording instruments in the examination premises.

Before the candidates write the answers, paper code, paper title, roll number should be filled in answer book correctly and the corresponding circle should be darkened as per the instructions.</p> <p>8. Candidate shall use only Blue or Black ball pen in the answer booklet. Use of ink pen, ball-pen of any other color (except blue and black) or pencil by the candidate in the Answer booklet shall be considered as use of unfair means.</p> <p>9. The candidate must note that his/her admission to the Test is strictly "Provisional". The mere fact that Admit card Ticket has been issued to a candidate does not imply that the candidature has been finally cleared by JKSPDC or that the entries made by the candidate in his/her application for the test have been accepted by the Commission as true and correct.</p> <p>10. If manual correction has been done on your admit card i.e. corrections with the stamp of JKSPDC and signature of authorized person, the same shall have to be submitted to the examiner at the end of the examination.</p>	<p>7. Do not write your Examination Roll Number/any identification mark at any other place other than the space provided on the title cover of the Answer Book.</p> <p>8. Do not write any matter except your Examination Roll No. on your question paper.</p> <p>9. Making appeals to/communicating with the evaluator in the answer book will tantamount to use of unfair means.</p> <p>10. No candidate will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the time is over.</p> <p>11. The candidate should not talk with any examinee and should not disturb smooth functioning of the Examination Centre during the examination.</p> <p>12. The examinees should check their pockets, desks, etc. immediately after they occupy their seats. If any paper written or otherwise is found, it should be handed over to the invigilator on duty.</p> <p>13. Before writing on the answer book the candidates should see that they have been supplied correct question paper as per the date sheet and also the question paper/ OMR sheet supplied to them is not damaged on any account.</p>
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
